


WHY LEARN TO DRAW?

Karl Marx


Learning English from pictures will help students to do this.


IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

- 1. The most important thing about the pictures you draw in that they show the meaning of the word. Don't worry if the drawing isn't very good it doesn't matter. Sometimes it's better if the drawing is a bit odd the students will remember it better. Drawings help to make your lessons more interesting, so don't think you can't draw you can!
- 2. As you draw ask questions about what you're drawing, eg: "What's this?"/"Where is he?"/"What's he doing?" etc.
- 3. First draw the big things, then draw the little things. For example draw the head and body before drawing the eyes or the mouth.
- 4. Blackboard drawings should be clear and simple. Don't draw unnecessary details like teeth, fingers, clothes etc.



5. Make sure that each part of the body is the right size, and make sure it's in the right place, eq:





For drawing people, these proportions are approximately correct. NB. The knees are half-way down the legs, the elbows are halfway down the arms.



Drawing a Face






Draw the eyes where the first line would be and the mouth where the second line would be. The nose ques in the middle.





Drawing children's faces

Divide the face in half. Draw the features on the lower half.




