

NESA Data

NESA tests are given to all students in grades 3-8 and 11 in Math and Reading. Therefore, NESA results for 9-12 only include one grade (11th).

In science, only grades 5, 8 and 11 take the test; thus, only one grade is tested in each of the categories (3-5, 6-8, and 9-12) listed on the state site.

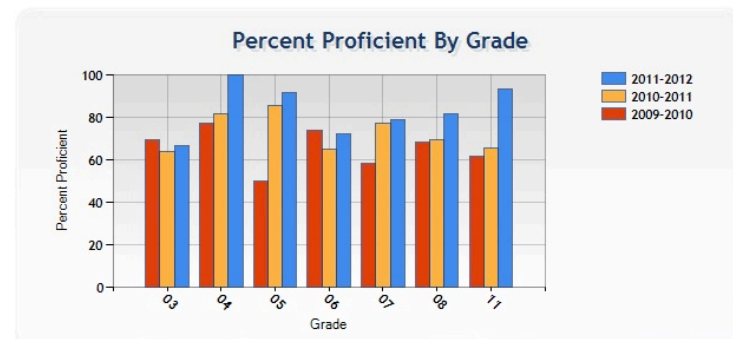

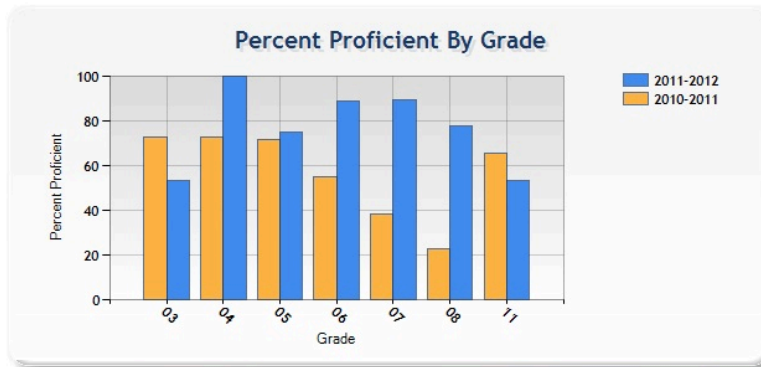

Lyons-Decatur Northeast has improved in students in grades 4 through 8 in NESA math. Grades 3 and 11 showed a slight decline in NESA math. Over-all proficiency went from 56.25% in 2010-2011 to 76.92% in 2011-2012.

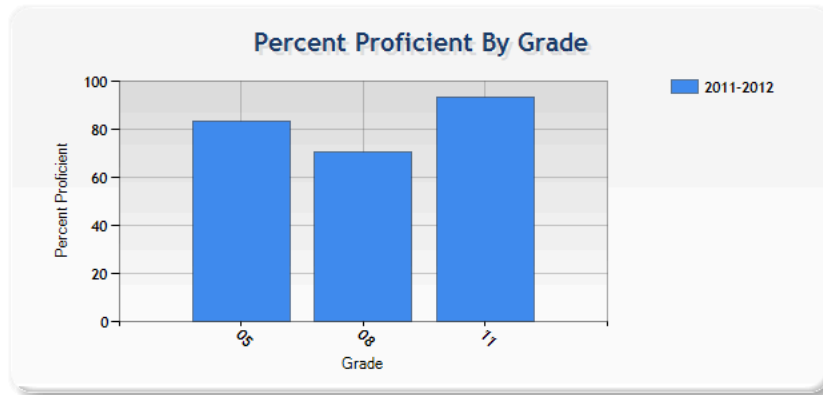
