SYMBOL	MEANING	EXAMPLES
<b>S</b>	Incorrect spelling / Palabra mal escrita	The book <sup>S</sup> <u>Inglish</u>
<b>W.O.</b>	Wrong word order / Orden incorrecto de la palabra	<sup>w.o</sup> <u>Always I am happy here</u>
<b>W.T.</b>	Wrong tense / Tiempo incorrecto	<sup>WT</sup> She <u>swims</u> yesterday
<b>W.W.</b>	Wrong word / Palabra incorrecta	<sup>w.w.</sup> I <u>made</u> my homework
<b>S-V</b>	Concord Subject and verb do not agree / No hay coherencia entre sujeto y verbo	<sup>s-v</sup> You <u>is</u> a student.
<b>WF</b>	Wrong form / Forma incorrecta	She can <sup>WF</sup> <u>plays</u> tennis.
<b>s/p</b>	Singular or plural form wrong / No hay concordancia entre singular y plural	<sup>s/p</sup> There are <u>hospital</u> .
<b>?M</b>	Meaning is not clear / El significado no está claro	<sup>?M</sup> I like <u>to me much house</u> .
<b>P</b>	Wrong punctuation / Puntuación incorrecta	<sup>P</sup> Whats <sup>P</sup> <u>your name</u> .
<b>^</b>	Add or insert a missing word / Agregar o inserter palabra(s) que faltan	I read <sup>^</sup> book
<b>Ø</b>	Not applicable / Not necessary (No se aplica / No es necesario)	Carlos went to <sup>Ø</sup> <u>the</u> Lima every month.
<b>(</b>	Start a new paragraph / Empezar un nuevo párrafo	Whenever there are two very different ideas in a paragraph.
<b>Cap</b>	Capitalization / Mayúsculas	<sup>Cap</sup> <u>t</u> here is a chair.
<b>■</b>	Start a new sentence / Empezar una nueva oración	The weather is nice <sup>■</sup> <u>here</u> <u>it's</u> warm all the time
<b>WP</b>	Wrong preposition / Preposición incorrecta	<sup>WP</sup> I live <u>at</u> Trujillo
<b>WPN</b>	Wrong Pronoun / Pronombre incorrecto	Carlos and Jose are students. <sup>WPN</sup> <u>He</u> live near here.
