







Pohick Bay Regional Park Vegetation & Wildlife Habitat

1. Areas depicted as "WET" and portions of the hardwood forest have a high potential for wetland resources regulated under the Clean Water Act. The boundaries depicted on this map, based on a wetlands reconnaissance, are approximate. In order to accurately determine the location of Jurisdictional Wetlands and/or Waters of the U.S., a wetlands delineation will be necessary. This delineation should be completed prior to any detailed land planning efforts.
2. The extent of the invasive species is approximate, depicting locations with know populations that were encountered during the environmental resources inventory. These species, in all likelihood, occur in other areas of the Park.
