Saving a Cmap on a public server

You can copy a Cmap to a *place* in the CmapTools network, making it possible to share Cmaps with others.

To save your map in the folder for your class, follow the steps below:

1. From the "Views - CmapTools" window, select the first IHMC Public Cmaps folder.

2. From the list that appears, scroll down to the folder called McGill COMS.

3. After you save your map in this folder, it will also be available as a web page, at the URL that appears at the bottom of the window.
