Intensive Pronouns

<u>Intensive pronouns</u> emphasize, or intensify, nouns and pronouns. Typically, we find them right after the noun they're intensifying. These pronouns typically end in -self or -selves. They are:

- myself
- himself
- herself
- themselves
- itself
- yourself
- yourselves
- ourselves

For example:

- I myself like to travel.
- He himself is his worst critic.
- She approved the marriage herself.
- We went to hear W.B. Yeats himself speak.
