Adverbs of place tell us more about where the verb took place. These tend to pop up after the <u>main verb</u> or <u>direct object</u> of the sentence. Here are some common adverbs of place:

- above
- below
- everywhere
- here
- in
- inside
- into
- nowhere
- out
- outside
- there

Let's take a look at them in action:

- In Ireland, there are thatched-roof cottages everywhere.
- Clearly, there aren't any leprechauns here.
- I was so beguiled, I drove into a ditch.
