Adverbs of manner tell us how, or in what manner, something was carried out. They mostly modify verbs and can often be found at the end of a clause. This category comprises the most common adverbs - the ones that <u>end in -ly</u>. Here are some examples of adverbs of manner:

- beautifully
- generously
- happily
- neatly
- patiently
- softly
- quickly
- well

And here are some example sentences:

- He trimmed the white roses **neatly**.
- I combed my dog's fur carefully because it had lots of tangles.
- There's no reason why you can't discuss the topic with me calmly.
